

The Need: Many families dealing with a medical emergency, homelessness, or joblessness face a heartbreaking choice: not getting the help they need or leaving their children in an unsafe situation, which could lead to foster care placement. The foster care reunification process is difficult, and the average time a child stays in care is more than a year.

The Vision: Through Harbor Families, our church can extend the hope, restoration, and love of Jesus Christ to children and families experiencing a crisis, helping keep families together.

The How: We are looking for Christ-centered host families to provide temporary care for children through Harbor Families. Other volunteers are needed to support parents who are working through a crisis. The physical, emotional, and spiritual support provided through the body of Christ can help prevent the need for foster care.
