ADOPTION AND PREGNANCY COUNSELING

\$465,938

- Domestically: Aim to enhance support for birth mothers by 10% across 35 states, while also boosting the facilitation of special needs adoptions by 10%.
- Internationally: Introduce two new programs and achieve a 10% increase in both the number of applications and children placed in adoptive homes.

GLOBAL ORPHAN CARE

Cultivate and strengthen strategic partnerships to foster cross-cultural learning, enabling 250 families to engage within global communities to adopt or foster children.

EDUCATION AND COUNSELING

Mobilize communities dedicated to the care of vulnerable children through six premium regional live events. Position ourselves as leaders in self-directed learning for adoptive and foster families by providing counseling and education to 4,000 families.

FAMILY PRESERVATION

Strive to increase the number of children served who are aging out of foster care by 15%, while establishing a national family preservation partnership that expands Lifeline's impact across all 50 states.


