What is the age of children eligible to be adopted?

The eligible children are 18 months-14 years old. Many of the children are older than 3.

Are sibling groups able to be adopted?

Yes, sibling groups are able to be adopted. One of the siblings is typically older than 6 years old.

Are children with and without medical special needs (MSN) able to be adopted?

Yes, children between the ages of 0-7 years old will have moderate to severe medical special needs

Children older than 7 years old may have mild medical special needs.

Information on waiting children:

Lifeline's Taiwan Program is a Waiting Child Only Program, so the only children available for adoption through Lifeline are located on the Lifeline's website. This list is updated often when children may be added or removed. There is no referral system for matching in Lifeline's Taiwan Program.
